At our last meeting the biggest topic of conversation was the increases in our home insurance. While many of us are seeing 100% or more increase in our policies. I took some suggestions from members who were able to see their insurance premiums either stay the same or have a slight increase. To be quite honest with you, none suggested were able to save me or others any money. What I did do, was pay for a 4-point inspection and a wind mitigation. Without those my premiums would have skyrocketed. I used Will Stephens of Coastal Home Inspections. Will gives a discount to police and firefighters. His business card information is included with the business sponsors. The healthcare battles continue. A Manhattan judge ordered Mayor Adams' administration Wednesday 1/11/23 to immediately stop charging retired city workers \$15 co-pays for doctors' visits.

The ruling from Manhattan Supreme Court Justice Lyle Frank marks the latest in a long string of health insurance setbacks for Adams' administration, which has tried unsuccessfully for over a year to shift the city's 250,000 retirees into a controversial, cost-cutting Medicare Advantage Plan. The co-pay case is separate from the Advantage dilemma, but also pertains to how the city bankrolls health care for retired municipal workers.

Last January, the \$15 co-pay was imposed on retirees benefiting from city-backed Medicare plans? a charge the administration estimated would allocate significant savings at a time that it is scrambling to address gaping budget deficits and skyrocketing health care costs.

A lot of emails were going around about calling and flooding the city with phone calls about the Medicare advantage plan. Received and email stating "Please pause on making phone calls and emails to the City Council until further notice as advised by us! Let's take breather, things are happening".

Mayor Eric Adams came under fire Friday 1/13/23 over his plan to slash funding for city cops and other essential services — while hoarding \$15 billion to pay for new municipal union contracts.

The NYPD saw 3,701 cops retire or resign in 2022, the most since the post-9/11 exodus in 2002, when 3,846 cops said goodbye to the job. Pension fund numbers reveal the 2022 exits are 32% more than the 2,811 who left in 2021. Bail reform, resentment for the city's vaccination mandate, the defund-the-police movement, cops feeling disrespected, and the lure of higher pay and lower stress proved to be the final push out the door for many cops.

Florida Gov. Ron DeSantis, who is vocal about his support for police agencies, launched the Law Enforcement Recruitment Bonus Payment Program, which offers officers from other states up to \$5,000 as a sign-on bonus.

Our next membership event will take place during the St. Patrick's Day weekend here in Port Saint Lucie. Like the years in the past, we will again be marching in the parade. This year will have a float for the members who want to join us but who can not physically walk the distance because of health conditions. We will also have a booth set up for recruitment. The years in the past, we were successful in gaining new members. Many of the members were either new to the area or just didn't know that this organization was here for them. Also the board has decided to host our annual BBQ for sometime in April. I will be going over to the city to find out what their available weekends are. I will keep you all posted.
