Tom, teamed up with various agencies to develop an early warning system to help find violent criminals that injure or kill law enforcement officers. The name Blue Alert is named using the Thin Blue Line theme associated with law enforcement. Other states and communities are soon to set up their own Blue Alert Systems as the concept is adopted across the nation. President Obama, Signed the Blue Alert into Law on May 19, 2015. Tom also started the Blue Alert Foundation in 2012 to help families of Fallen Law Enforcement Officers killed in the line of duty.

Two years ago, we sadly lost Florida State Trooper Joseph Bullock on February 5, 2020. Trooper Bullock was shot and killed in the line of duty while helping a disabled motorist on interstate 95 who did not want to pay his tow bill. The community lost a hero, Tom Berry lost a friend. This past Saturday marking 2 years since, Tom arranged that the Bullock family and friends be escorted by a long line of motorcycles to the portion of I-95 in Martin County where Trooper Bullock was shot and killed. "Trooper Joseph Bullock Memorial Highway." The area is between mile markers 105 and 110 on the northbound side. Myself, Steve (VP) and John (Sec) and many member of the Treasure Coast 1013 had the sad honor of participating.

The deadline for filing the Notice of Participation with the New York Police Pension Fund is September 11, 2022. This is the last time the deadline will be extended. Make sure you have filed the Notice of Participation to be eligible for disability benefits should you become ill from your 9/11 rescue and recovery work. The Notice of Participation Form can be found on the NYPD Police Pension Fund website. I also have a copy if you should need it. If you believe you already filed, but are not sure, the Police Pension Fund has listed all the Tax ID numbers of those whose paperwork they've already received under "WTC Information" on the left side of the home page. https://www1.nyc.gov/html/nycppf/html/wtc_information/wtc_information.shtml

First, click on "WTC Information" and check the pdf file to see if your number is listed. If it is, then you do not have to re-file. However, if your number does not appear, you must file the form (even if you currently have no symptoms of illness) by September 11, 2022 to be eligible in the future in case of illness and/or death.




