All applicants must be entering their first year of college. Applications must be filled out to the best of ability, sponsored and notarized. All applications must be submitted and received, or post marked on or before July 15th of the current year. All scholarship applications are due by & must be postmarked by **JULY 15, 2022**.

In November, news broke that LHI — the company responsible for administering health monitoring for 9/11 first responders outside the NYC area, had lost its government contract. Th National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH), said NIOSH would be delaying the handover to the new company "to allow more time for a smooth transition." NIOSH had indicated that the transition between firms could take place as early as "late spring 2022." LHI will continue to provide services until the new contractor takes over. The original take over was supposed to be (April 4th) but NIOSH said the agency recently decided to move the transition date to late summer/fall to allow more time for a smooth transition.

The deadline for filing the Notice of Participation with the New York Police Pension Fund is September 11, 2022. This is the last time the deadline will be extended. Make sure you have filed the Notice of Participation to be eligible for disability benefits should you become ill from your 9/11 rescue and recovery work. The Notice of Participation Form can be found on the NYPD Police Pension Fund website. I also have a copy if you should need it. If you believe you already filed, but are not sure, the Police Pension Fund has listed all the Tax ID numbers of those whose paperwork they've already received under "WTC Information" on the left side of the home page. https://www1.nyc.gov/html/nycppf/html/wtc_information/wtc_information.shtml

First, click on "WTC Information" and check the pdf file to see if your number is listed. If it is, then you do not have to re-file. However, if your number does not appear, you must file the form (even if you currently have no symptoms of illness) by September 11, 2022 to be eligible in the future in case of illness and/or death.

Ask yourself, if you were in a crash or other emergency situation, couldn't talk and your cell phone was locked, how would your family and friends be notified?

If you register your emergency contact information (ECI) into the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles system, law enforcement can contact your loved ones for you, and quickly, even across state lines. ECI is a secure system that only law enforcement nationwide can access in order to contact your designated family or friends in response to an emergency situation.

Who will have access to my info? Law Enforcement Agencies have access for the purpose of contacting those you have listed in the event of an emergency. As of July 1, 2022, pursuant to s. 394.463(2)(a) or s. 397.6772(1)(a), a receiving facility, hospital, or licensed detoxification or addictions receiving facility has access to your emergency contact information for the sole purpose of notifying those you have listed of your whereabouts.

Will my information be used for any other purpose? No. This information is only used to notify the contacts that you designate in the event of an emergency.

Why was this system developed? The system was first developed in Florida because there was no emergency contact program in place to quickly notify loved ones in the event of an emergency. ECI was initiated by Christine Olson in loving memory of her daughter Tiffiany because she was involved in a fatal crash and it was over 6 hours before Christine was notified.

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


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
