Greetings to my Brothers/ Sisters in Blue,

On March 25, 2024, NYPD hero Jonathan Diller was shot and killed as he was protecting the citizens of New York City. What makes this infuriating is that he was shot by a convicted felon who had 21 prior arrests and should have never been on the streets. Police Officer Jonathan Diller, a 31-year-old married father, had been on the force for three years when he was shot and killed. During his three-year career, Diller racked up more than 70 arrests. His final collar was just a few days before his death "when he took a loaded gun off the streets. Diller, whose brother-in-law and cousin are both cops, leaves behind a wife, Stephanie, and the couple's 1-year-old son, Ryan. During the funeral service, Commissioner Caban promoted Officer Diller to detective and vowed to his family that the NYPD will stand by them for life.

We raised \$750.00 during our March meeting from our membership and the Treasure Coast 1013 Club matched it, totaling \$1500.00 going to the Diller family. The 10-13 Check was mailed on 3/27 to Nassau County 7th Pct Lt Michael Byrne who organized the donation drive for P.O. Diller's wife and son. Please keep the Diller family in your thoughts and prayers and for any officer who is in harm's way.

During our March meeting, the Treasure Coast 10-13 and with the help of Sheriff Keith Pearson we presented Saint Lucie County Sheriff's Office firearms instructor Brian Jerome with a certificate of appreciation for sharing his expertise with our retired law enforcement officers during our yearly HR 218 qualification and certification.

Saint Patrick's Day parade was well attended. We had fun. You could hear the New Yorkers in the crowd as they were shouting and clapping for all of us. AIC had the NYPD scooter, Jim S and Ed R both drove antique police cars. The pictures are on our website.

MEDICARE PART B 2022 REIMBURSEMENT

MEDICARE-ELIGIBLE RETIREES AND THEIR MEDICARE-ELIGIBLE DEPENDENTS WILL BE REIMBURSED ANNUALLY FOR THE STANDARD MEDICARE PART B AMOUNT OF \$170.10 PER MONTH ($\$170.10 \times 12 \text{ MONTHS} = \$2,041.20$), EXCLUDING ANY PENALTIES AND LATE ENROLLMENT FEES, AND SUBJECT TO BE PRO-RATED.

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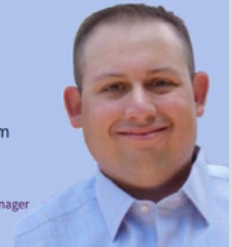

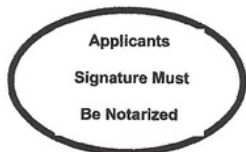
