Greetings to my Brothers/ Sisters in Blue,

On March 25, 2024, NYPD hero Jonathan Diller was shot and killed as he was protecting the citizens of New York City, What make this infuriating is that he was shot by a convicted felon who had 21 prior arrests and should have never been on the streets. Police Officer Jonathan Diller, a 31-year-old married father, had been on the force for three years when he was shot and killed. During his three-year career, Diller racked up more than 70 arrests. His final collar was just a few days before his death "when he took a loaded gun off the streets. Diller, whose brother-in-law and cousin are both cops, leaves behind a wife, Stephanie, and the couple's 1-year-old son, Ryan. During the funeral service, Commissioner Caban promoted Officer Diller to detective and vowed to his family that the NYPD will stand by them for life.

We raised \$750.00 during our March meeting from our membership and the Treasure Coast 1013 Club matched it, totaling \$1500.00 going to the Diller family.8. The 10-13 Check was mailed on 3/27 to Nassau County 7th Pct Lt Michael Byrne who organized the donation drive for P.O. Diller's wife and son. 

Sponsor Information

This section is to be completely filled out by the Retired NYPD Officer, who is sponsoring your application.

Education Information

School presently attending

- 1. The name of the high school you are presently attending.

- 3. Your grade point average (GPA), weighted and un-weighted.
- 4. Your State Aptitude Scores (SAT), FCAT, ACT, etc.

Certification

The application must be signed by both you and your sponsor, and <u>your signature must be notarized</u> that all the information provided is true to the best of your knowledge. If further information is required you may be contacted by one of our trustees.

All applications will be graded by the TRUSTEES based on scholastic achievements and community involvement which is voluntary and not specifically required by the school for graduation. Arrangements for the award will be made through the educational facility and in accordance with their guidelines. 




